VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

_____ **Birthday Board**

Take photos and display them on our famous birthday board! We need teams of 2-3 people each month. Birthday Board jobs include going to school during lunch and photographing students; cutting and pasting photos onto backdrops (this part can be done at home); taking down the previous month's board; and putting up the new board, which is done on the last day of each month.

_____ **Book Fair (Fall & Spring)**

Help during the school day and/or after school selling books at our fall and spring sales.

_____ **Box Tops**

Help organize and count the Box Tops students clip and submit in order for Greenwood to redeem money from the Box Tops for Education program.

_____ **Courtyard & Grounds Beautification**

Help maintain the school gardens and courtyards by planting, weeding and mulching. If you have a green thumb or just love plants and the outdoors, this is the place for you. The courtyard coordinator determines when work is done.

_____ **Craft Night**

Assist with preparation, distribution and creation of wonderful crafts for the holiday season. This evening in November is a fun night for all, especially volunteers!

_____ **Earth Week**

Help plan and run a variety of weeklong activities in April celebrating our earth and teaching our children to care for its beauty and health.

_____ **Emergency Supplies Distribution**

Each year, PTA provides snacks and water bottles to all classrooms. These are set aside in case there's an emergency in which our children may be confined to their classrooms for a long period of time. We're looking for people to purchase the snacks and water (you'll be reimbursed) and to

distribute them to each class. This job needs to be done by the end of September.

Celebrate and build friendships with the entire *Greenwood* community! We need help setting up, cleaning up, planning, publicizing and preparing for a variety of evening events throughout the year, including:

This is a wonderful program that uses a variety of approaches to help children learn to form their letters and manipulate their pencils. Training is provided. Volunteers work with students all year during the school day.

_____ Health Week

Assist with our annual Health Week activities in November. This is a great opportunity to raise awareness for a health issue near and dear to your heart. Past weeks' themes have included asthma, diabetes and nutrition. Activities occur during the school day.

_____ Hearing & Vision Screening

We need your assistance in escorting students from their classrooms to the screening area. (Day and time to be determined.)

Provide drinks and other goodies for different events throughout the school year.

International Night

Have a passion for global culture? Help organize and run this May celebration of our students' cultural heritage.

Jump Rope For Heart

Help staff P.E. classes during the week of Jump Rope For Heart, a national community service project that Greenwood participates in each February.

Kindergarten Orientation

Help the Greenwood staff as they conduct a springtime orientation for next year's kindergartners and welcome new parents into the Greenwood family. Orientation is scheduled during the school day.

Math Facts/Gator Raiders

This program helps students in all grades master their math facts. Volunteers will help score the drills, track the results and make copies once a week throughout the school year.

Help publish Greenwood's literary magazine, "The Gator's Gallery," a showcase for our school's budding writers and illustrators. "The Gator's Gallery" is published two to three times a year. We need help digitizing the students' contributions, copying and collating.

Membership/Directory Assistance
